Project of the Year Award: The PM, Superintendent, Estimator, or Service Team Member (as applicable) for the winning project will be awarded a Weifield 2022 Trip of the Year (for themselves and a guest); the PM's, Superintendents, Estimators and Service Team Members for the second and third place projects as voted by Weifield employees will be awarded a monetary reward of \$750 each.

Project of the Year Award Criteria:

- Project Manager, Field Supervisor, Estimator, or Service Team Member must have company tenure of at least one year (as of 11/1/2022)
- All candidates must still be working for the company
- The project must have completed since the last All Hands meeting -- late 2021 or 2022
- Candidates must be a promoter of the company with positive attitudes and a teamwork focus
- Profit margins must be equal to or better than estimated
- Project must have a good safety record
- Punch list/call backs must be at a minimum
- Good to great customer feedback
- High quality of workmanship

This project experienced several delays, pushing the schedule into 2022 completion – including: delays on materials for a required fiber optic run to a nearby Smoky Hill storage tank, an undersized service transformer that was installed without Xcel Energy's approval, and disagreement between Parker Water and South Metro Water Supply Authority on the programming network needed to tie the flow monitoring facility to the remaining buildings (both municipalities share control of portions of this plant). Note from Curtis Miller, V.P. of Industrial Division: <i>"This project was a really great representation of our P.A.C.T values:</i> The people, from beginning to end, this project reflected what <u>relationships</u> can do for a project – as our relationships with all partners were grounded in transparency and trust. Our trusting relationships built through solid work ethic and great communication allowed for a successful project and allowed us to reach our ambitious gross margin goals. Advancing processes isn't just about building new processes, it is also about utilizing our processes within our vision. Due to our extensive process training at Weifield, we were very thorough and this allowed us to transition project leadership successfully. This is why it's important to FOLLOW and DO our process.
